

All competitors and spectators are required to have a current CMP card in their possession at all times while on the CMP property. If you don't have a card or if your card is expired please plan to get one as soon as you get to the range before checking in at the match registration desk. Everyone will be given a holder for the card. **Your CMP card must be worn while on** *the competition or practice bays and also will be checked daily by staff. This is a requirement of the range.*

PRACTICE

If you plan to practice you must pre-register and pay for practice. We will not be accepting payment for practice at the match. We have setup a "match" on PractiScore so you can register and pay. Failure to take care of this in advance will cause delays before you can practice. Please register for practice using this link (https:// practiscore.com/2023-wssc-practice/register).

PRACTICE BAYS

All 8 stages will be setup for Practice. Practice will run from 9:00 until approximately 6:00. We reserve the right to close practice bays early if needed. Per Alabama range protection act we are prohibited from shooting prior to 9:00. The Practice bays will open Tuesday morning at 9:00. Competitors MUST have current CMP card before using the practice bays. You will be required to show your card to a range official working the practice bays.

SHIPPING AMMO TO THE RANGE

Shipments must be sent to The CMP 4387 Turner Mill Road, Talladega, AL 35160. Everything needs to be to the attention of J.L. Hardy. Make certain your name and USPSA number are clearly visible on the outside of the package. Also remember ammo must have the Limited Quantity label and be shipped by either FedEX or UPS.

RECOGNITION

The 2023 SCSA World Speed Shooting Championship will recognize divisions and categories per the SCSA Rules, Appendix A2. Per Appendix A2, divisions and classes must have 10 or more competitors, and categories must have 5 or more competitors (within each division), to be recognized. Only qualifying Division, Class, Category, and Special Awards will be presented.

PRIZES

Cash prizes will be awarded to Steel Master, Rifle Master, Rimfire Master, and Division Winners. Winners of cash prizes will be issued vouchers and tax forms to claim their prize, which will be mailed to the address in their USPSA member profile.

Prize tables will be separated into three separate tables.

Competitors will walk a prize table for their best centerfire pistol placement by order of finish. Competitors will walk a prize table for their best

rimfire rifle or pistol placement by order of finish. Competitors will walk a prize table for their best PCC placement by order of finish.

Competitors may only walk for their highest finish in each of the three groups.

DIVISION SPECIFICATIONS

All thirteen SCSA divisions are eligible for competition at this event. For division specific requirements please consult the SCSA rules (https://scsa.org/rules) we will be using the March 2023 edition of the rule book for this event.

DISQUALIFICATION POLICY

Any competitor disqualified during the event will not be permitted to continue in the competition. This includes firearms scheduled for a later flight or the next day. Previously completed scores will remain as scored and the competitor remains eligible for awards and placement for those completed scores. Should a competitor have remaining slots registered in the event those slots are forfeited to USPSA to be resold or reassigned at their discretion.

steel challenge **RANGE POLICIES**

EYE AND EAR PROTECTION

All people on the range property must wear eye and ear protection — no exceptions. If you do not have eye and ear protection of your own, earplugs and safety glasses are available at the registration table.

COLD RANGE

All firearms on the range are to be unloaded and carried in a holster or case unless in a safety area, or at the specific command of a range officer on the line. There will be a designated area(s) for function firing and firearms handling.

SQUAD SCHEDULE

The shooting schedule will be adhered to. If a contestant arrives after their designated squad has concluded shooting, they will either fire the stage with the last squad of the day or be put with a later squad. This will be subject to the discretion of the Match Officials. The shooter may NOT reassign themselves to other squads of their choice.

PHOTOGRAPHIC RELEASE

By entering or attending the Steel Challenge, each participant authorizes unconditional use of his/ her likeness, name and match results for purposes of advertising and promotion without compensation, consideration, notice, review or consent.

PREPAREDNESS

Contestants are to go to the line prepared with the appropriate number of magazines, or speed loaders and needed ammunition, so as to not cause unnecessary delay. A contestant may have an assistant to help them in reloading magazines if needed.

ROUND COUNT

Competitors may fire as many rounds as they deem necessary for each string of fire. There are a minimum of 195 shots fired for the eight stages.

USE OF TENTS AND CANOPIES

There will be designated areas for function firing and firearms handling. The shaded holding area (canopy) at each stage is primarily for competitors. Friends and family members are allowed in this area only if not needed by competitors. Please respect the competitor's efforts by keeping the noise to a minimum. Anyone appearing to disturb a competitor's concentration will be asked to leave. **SAFETY AREAS:** The range is equipped with a number of safety areas to bag and holster guns, for dry fire practice and gun repair, etc. No ammunition may be handled in any safety area.

Parking Area: Competitor parking area is designated on the map. Competitors are not allowed to park across the bridge area or next to the bays.

RULES: The match rules are found in the current edition of the USPSA Competition Rules (2023 SCSA Rules).

OBEY YOUR RO: Range officers are here to assist you in completing a safe shooting contest. Please comply with their requests. Please bring any issues to the attention of the Range Master.

LOST BRASS: All brass is donated to the staff.

ALCOHOL: Alcohol and recreational drugs may not be consumed anywhere on the range. Competitors violating this policy will be disqualified and asked to leave the range.

DRESSCODE: Practical shooting is a sport. The match director will be the final arbiter of dubious taste.

REST ROOMS: Portable toilets are located conveniently around the range.

PARKING: Parking areas will be clearly marked on the range map. Competitors may only park in the competitor areas. Lock your car and take your valuables.

GUN HANDLING IN THE PARKING AREA IS PROHIBITED.

SPECTATORS: Everyone must wear eye protection while on the range and hearing protection is strongly suggested. Climbing on berms is not allowed. Children must be under the direct supervision of a parent. If you need eye protection, please see a range master.







he 2022 World Speed Championships Shooting were held from April 27th to May 1st at the Civilian Marksmanship Program (CMP) in Talladega Alabama. A new record was set for a Steel Challenge match as 712 guns were shot during the match, breaking the old record of 638 set back in 2018. There are a number of ups and downs in the divisions, but the biggest growth has been in RFRO. In 2018 there were 121 and in 2022 there were 174 (24.4% of the match). If you're wondering why there's been such a huge growth in this division, get out and shoot it. Shooting a 22lr rifle with a dot is just plain fun, and one of the fastest divisions available. Before you get your sights set on being the world champ, you're going to have to beat Kenny Nagata, who set the world record in RFRO at 54.4 this year. Speaking of world records, there were 5 total world match records set this year.

My squad followed Lance Bratcher Jr's squad on Sunday morning when he was shooting RFPI and recorded a new world record of 67.32, beating the old record of 69.05 set by Nate Gibson in 2021. However, that world record was short lived as the 2020 RFPI champion Neal Norman shot a 66.56 Sunday afternoon. As you can see, Kenny Nagata also won the RFPO division with a blistering

55.73 breaking the previous world record of 57.51 set last year by KC Eusebio. Chris Barrett continued his domination of the PCCI division, winning for the 3rd year in a row and setting a new world record of 57.47. Rounding out the recap of the new world records is another great shooter, Grant Kunkel. Grant won the PCCO division with a smoking 56.66, breaking the old record of 59.27 set by Kenny Nagata last year. Grant was also the winner of the RFRI division, turning in a blistering 57.73. While this was off from his world record time of 53.97 set in 2021, it was enough for the division win.

The center fire divisions had some old winners and a new one. The newest world champion is Nils Jonasson who took home the CO title with a 90.48. The OSR title, his 7th in a row, went to Michael Poggie. Just behind him in the repeat department was KC Eusebio who won his 5th world title in the OPN division. Becoming a world champion is tough, but doing it 5 and 7 times IN A ROW, that's impressive. Gorka Ibanez had a

three peat in SS with a 96.48, beating his time from last year by almost 7 seconds. This also puts him in an elite group of 5 that have ever broken 100 in SS. Sal Luna repeated in PROD with an 89.38 making him only the 5th person ever to break 90 in the division. Moving on to LTD, after a 2 year hiatus, BJ Norris was back at the WSSC in 2022. He took the division with a blazing 83.13. BJ now has the 6 fastest match times ever shot in this division.

magazine, I described the special categories that are in the Steel Challenge. The WSSC recognizes these awards, which are Rimfire Master, Rifle Master and Steel Master. To compete for Rimfire master you must shoot RFPI, RFPO, RFRI and RFRO. This year the title was won by Grant Kunkel with a combined 248.03. I did some digging and also found out that this was the fastest time ever for this special award. To compete in Rifle Master, you must shoot PCCO or PCCI and RFRO or RFRI. This year's rifle master was Kenny Nagata with a 111.69, also the fastest time ever shot for this award. Now on to Steel Master, the oldest of the special awards. To compete in for this award, you must shoot two guns from the center fire division but only one can have optic, and then either RFPO or RFPI. In the past this special award is usually won by shooting OPN, LTD and RFPO, and it's usually won by a male. Neither of those was true this year. The winner shot OPN, SS and RFPO and was won by Jessie Harrison, one of the most decorated ladies in WSSC history. In the past 4 years, Jessie had always finished in the top 5, but this year she beat last year's total by over 10 seconds and claimed the top spot.

One of the great things about the WSSC is that there are also category awards. Those categories are pre-teen, junior, senior, super senior, law, military and foreign. To win, there must be at least 5 competitors in the division for the category to be recognized for any award, however, that isn't a requirement for a world record. During the awards and on the website the overall and lady world records are recognized, but for this article, I'm recognizing all of the categories as long as there have been at least 5 people who have shot the division since 2009. In the pre teen category, Carleigh Chadwick won RFRO and set a new world record. Carleigh also set new world records in 3 other divisions.

The junior division was dominated by Kenny Nagata where he won OPN, RFRO, RFPO, PCCO and PCCI. Kylie Wells took home the junior award in RFPI and Nate Gibson win RFRI. Kenny also set 4 new junior world records.

Slowly becoming one of the more heated categories at the WSSC is the senior category.

This year was no exception. James Rushing took RFRI and Mark Weaver took RFPI. Bob Halsell was a double winner in RFRO and PCCO with PCCO being his 2nd in a row. Leighton Oosthuisen a first timer at the WSSC was another double winner in CO and OPN. Jeff Jones rounded out the senior category titles with PCCI and his 3rd in a row in RFPO. Here is the new world records set this year

In the Super Senior category, George Jones won the OPN division. George was an RO, so he shot this on the first day and it held the entire match to win him a senior title. Karl Sutterlin dominated all of the other division winning RFRO (3rd in a row), PCCO (3rd in a row), RFRI and RFPO. Karl was also able to achieve another milestone, he's the first super senior to shoot under 70 with a 68.95 in RFRO, way to go Karl!

The military division doesn't usually have enough competitors to recognize an award, but 2022 was different. First off I'd like to thank our military competitors, Jonathan Cypert, Gatlin Johnson, David Johnson, Natalie Mignano, Marc Santos, Michael Wallace and Mike Willoughby, thank you for your service. In both RFRO and RFPO, the military category champion was Gatlin Johnson. Gatlin also set 2 new military world records.

The lady category was also represented well again this year. Carleigh Chadwick won RFRI, Jenna Larsen won RFRO, Jessie Harrison won OPN and Justine Williams won PCCO. Kylie wells cleaned up with 3 lady titles in PCCI, RFPI and RFPO. Something that I think is great this year; the lady category was combined with the other age based categories to recognize more shooters. In RFPO, RFRO and RFRI, Kylie Wells won lady junior. Justine Williams took the lady junior title in PCCO. When her name was announced, I don't think I've seen anyone with a bigger smile as Diane McCoy won the lady super senior title in PCCO.

Class winners were also recognized at the awards ceremony and while I'd like to mention each and every one here, there just isn't enough room. Needless to say, you're all champions. There are 104 division/stage combinations and this year there were 23 new world records set. I can't list them all, but I will let you know that 6 of those new stage records were in speed option.

If you never attended the WSSC I highly recommend it. Yes, it's the same stages you shoot at your local match, but these are perfectly measured and laser leveled to the correct height. Each stage has a team of ROs ensuring the commands are given correctly and that hits and misses are called correctly. The atmosphere is awesome with the vendors in the middle of the stages; everyone is going to have to walk by them at least once during every session. This year the awards were off site at the race track and I personally thought it was awesome. The room was spacious and of course they had the WSSC banner set up for photo ops before, during and after awards. I felt honored to be asked to do the award announcements and tried to make every winner feel great when they heard their name called. The prize tables were stocked well by the sponsors and Spanky did a great job calling the names. Next year's WSSC will again be in Talladega at the CMP from May 3rd to May 7th, I'll be there and I hope to see you there too.

NOTE: <u>DO NOT SHIP AMMUNITION BY THE UNITED STATES POSTAL SERVICE</u>! IT IS A VIOLATION OF FEDERAL LAW TO DO SO, AND YOU WILL BE LIABLE FOR ANY LEGAL ISSUES. WE ARE CONSIDERING NOT RECEIVING ANY AMMO SHIPPED THROUGH THE POSTAL SERVICE, AND THEIR CARRIERS MAY DECLINE TO DELIVER IT. YOU MUST SHIP BY COMMERCIAL CARRIER, UPS OR FEDEX OR ANY OTHER CARRIER THAT WILL SHIP AMMO—<u>NOT</u> THE USPS.

1) Use a very sturdy box and lots of tape. Ammo is heavy and the carriers will not treat that box like a carton of eggs. Do not place ammo inside the box loose; use plastic or cardboard boxes with separators designed to hold ammunition. That's usually a requirement for all commercial carriers. Place lots of padding around the ammo boxes. **DO NOT SHIP IT IN AN ENVELOPE**.

2) Put **YOUR** name and "Steel Challenge/WSSC" on the outside of the box, in big, **bold** letters, and covered with clear tape. *Put it there in at least 3 different locations*. In addition, insert a business card, or a small piece of paper inside the box with all of your contact information. Some boxes get damaged in shipment, making the outside illegible. The information inside will help determine who the owner is, and allow them to contact you should some of your ammunition be lost due to damaged packaging.

3) UPS/FedEx will ship ammo, ground only, if it's properly marked with an ORM-D Label. Be sure to package your ammo securely in boxes designed to hold ammunition, and use a sturdy box and <u>lots</u> of tape. Most UPS stores and FedEx Office will not accept ammo shipments; you can hand them to a route person, schedule a pickup, or take them to a UPS/FedEx depot/service center.


4) Ship your ammo in time for it to arrive prior to the match. It must go ground, per UPS and/or FedEx regulations, so give it time to get there. Again: <u>NO AMMO BY US POSTAL SERVICE</u>. The folks at CMP Marksmanship Park will collect your ammunition and store it until USPSA personnel are on the ground at the range. We (USPSA) will distribute it at or around registration or during the match. It will be better if you collect your ammunition during registration periods so that we can assure that we have people on hand to distribute it. You may be required to sign for any ammunition you pick up. If you want to collect your ammo at times other than registration, you may experience a delay in getting it until someone is free.
